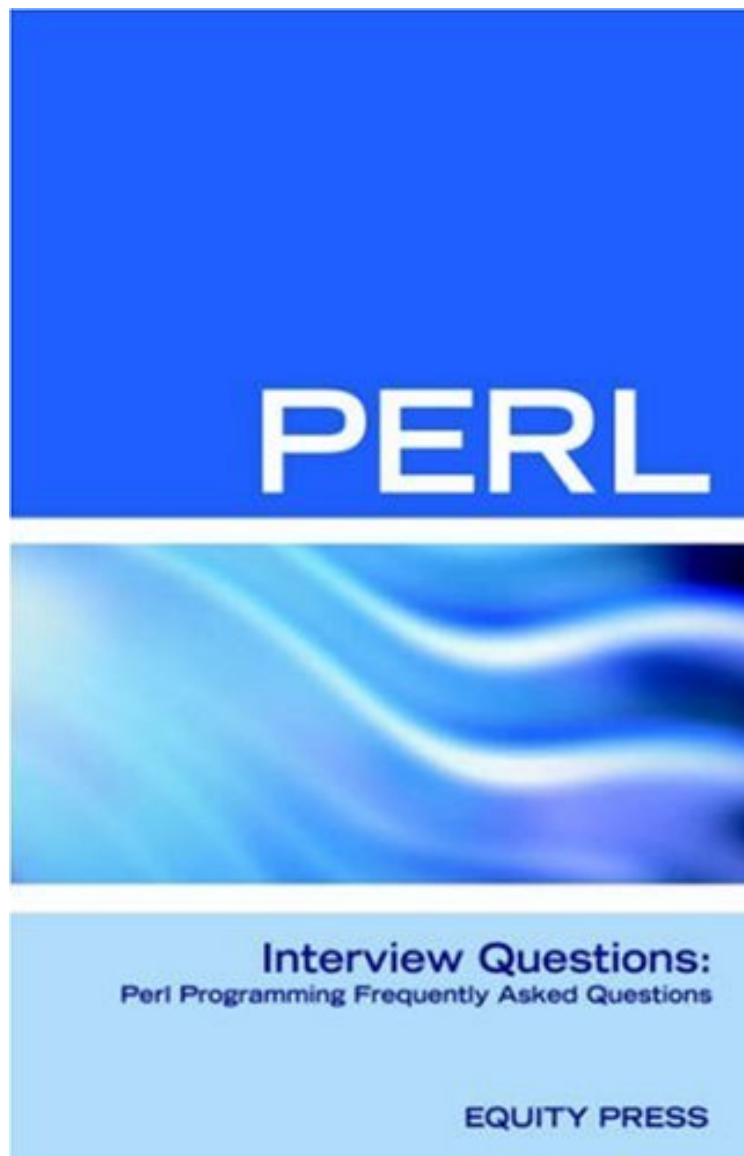

Most of the content in this book is plagiarized from online sources. I easily recognized the writing of several Perl people I know even though the book gives them cursory credit at the end in a completely deficient bibliography of five URLs. By googling the lead sentence of many answers, I found the true source of much of the content. Indeed, the book has no author because the publisher stole the material. The editor clearly has no connection with Perl, or thought she could get by without doing any work. The mishmash of styles, bogus or dated information, and lack of technical review make this a mine field for anyone studying for an interview. Not only is the food awful, but the portions are so small. There are less than 200 pages in this book, and many of them are half pages or completely without content. That the price is so high only underscores the dishonest intent of the publisher.
