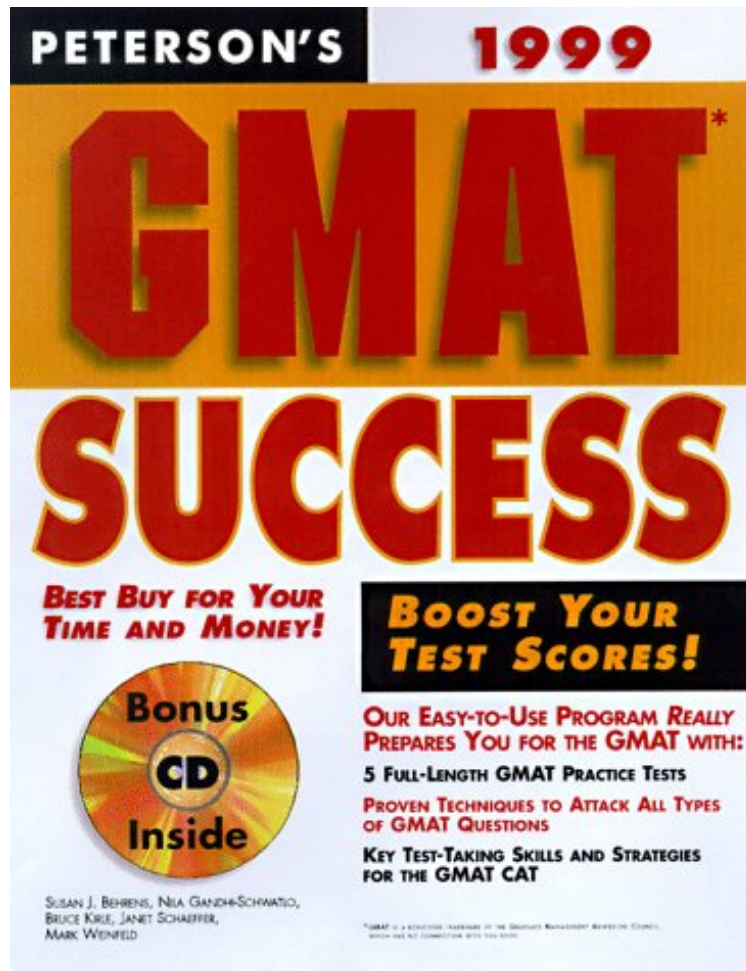

The Peterson's Guide has turned out to be a disappointment in helping me to study for the GMAT CAT. The most blurring problem with this study guide is that it repeatedly gives you advice on how to take the written GMAT, yet it promotes itself as the 1999 version. Perhaps Peterson's doesn't realize that the GMAT is now only offered on the computer (CAT) for students in the United States. I don't think the CAT test centers would appreciate it if I were to circle key words or phrases in the Reading Comprehension section, as the Peterson's Guide suggests. While the math review is sufficient and some of the suggestions are well-made, I've found that this information can be found in other study guides that will also focus on the GMAT CAT. If you can't decide, "What is the author's tone in this passage", I suggest that you look somewhere other than Peterson's Guide to find the answer. 8 of 8 people found the following
