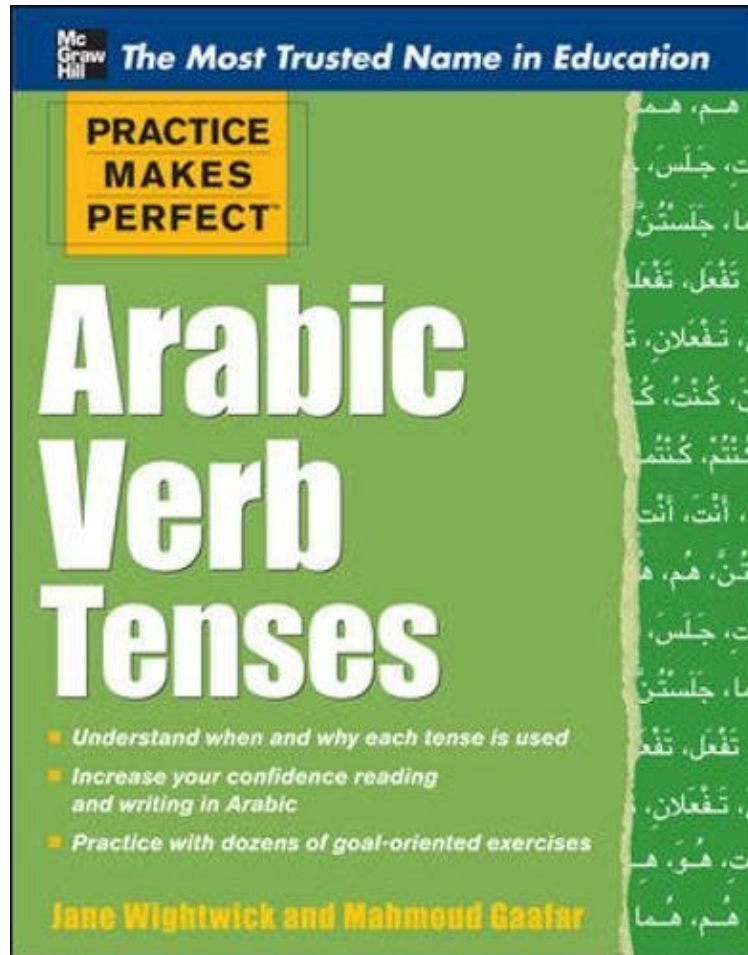

It's a workbook presenting concepts one at a time with practice. Concepts are introduced in English, so there is no need to worry about learning (and then recalling) grammar concept terms in Arabic to be able to use the book. (This is in contrast to the second edition of the Georgetown University Press Al-Kitaab textbook).This resource does not come with audio files. I have not noted much transliteration, either. So, you will want to know Arabic script already. I'd say that this resource would be good after about a semester's worth of study of the language.In my opinion, other than lacking audio files, this book presents

Arabic verbs and usage in a MUCH more user-friendly manner than my old second edition Al-Kitaab textbook (although Al-Kitaab did provide DVDs that definitely helped with pronunciation). I am learning a LOT more useful verbs in much shorter time than with my old Al-Kitaab text. So, unless you have access to a great, well-rounded Arabic textbook, I recommend this book for explanations and practice with Arabic verbs.
