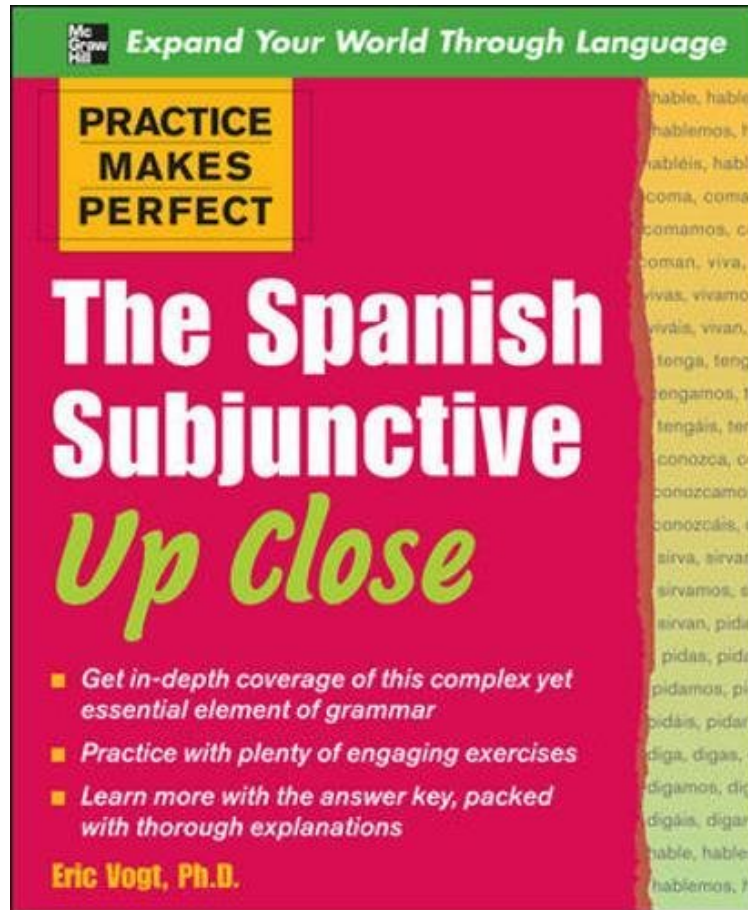

I was able to skim through most of it, being already familiar with the subjunctive, but I found extremely useful to have both types of explanations in one book. The exercises are good, and they use a variety of different exercises to really examine your understanding of the subject. Explanations for correct/incorrect answers are only provided for some exercises, but even that is really helpful. The "Up Close" title of the book makes it clear that this book is best used by someone who is familiar with, but inexperienced in, using the subjunctive. 6 of 6 people found the following review helpful. to help reinforce what I had learned in a class. The explanations are clear followed by plenty of exercises. A **STRENGTH** of this book is that the answer key contains an explanation for EACH answer. So, if you get an answer wrong, you'll know exactly why. This book is smaller and thinner than the other PMP Spanish books. That is convenient because I carry it with me when I'm out and read and practice from it while I am waiting on an appointment or waiting on food in a restaurant. A **WEAKNESS** of this book is that there are many pages of instruction that are then followed by many exercises. I find a short snippet of instruction quickly followed by short exercises is best as that provides immediate reinforcement of what is being learned. Because this book contains several pages of instruction before getting to related exercises, I gave it four stars instead of five. Having said that, overall, the book is very helpful. I've bought a few PMP Spanish workbooks and if I were to do it over again based on what I know now, I would buy this book again. This book is likely best for intermediate and advanced learners. In addition to gaining a more solid understanding of the Spanish subjunctive, I frankly learned a few things about English verb tenses and moods. I've been a writer and editor in English for more than 20 years, and was humbled by this book. Plan to complete each of the exercises carefully, more than once. (Don't write the answers directly in the book so you can repeat as needed.) The subjunctive is one of those skill areas that atrophies with neglect. I find that running through the exercises for practice just before a Spanish-language encounter raises my credibility a notch every time.
