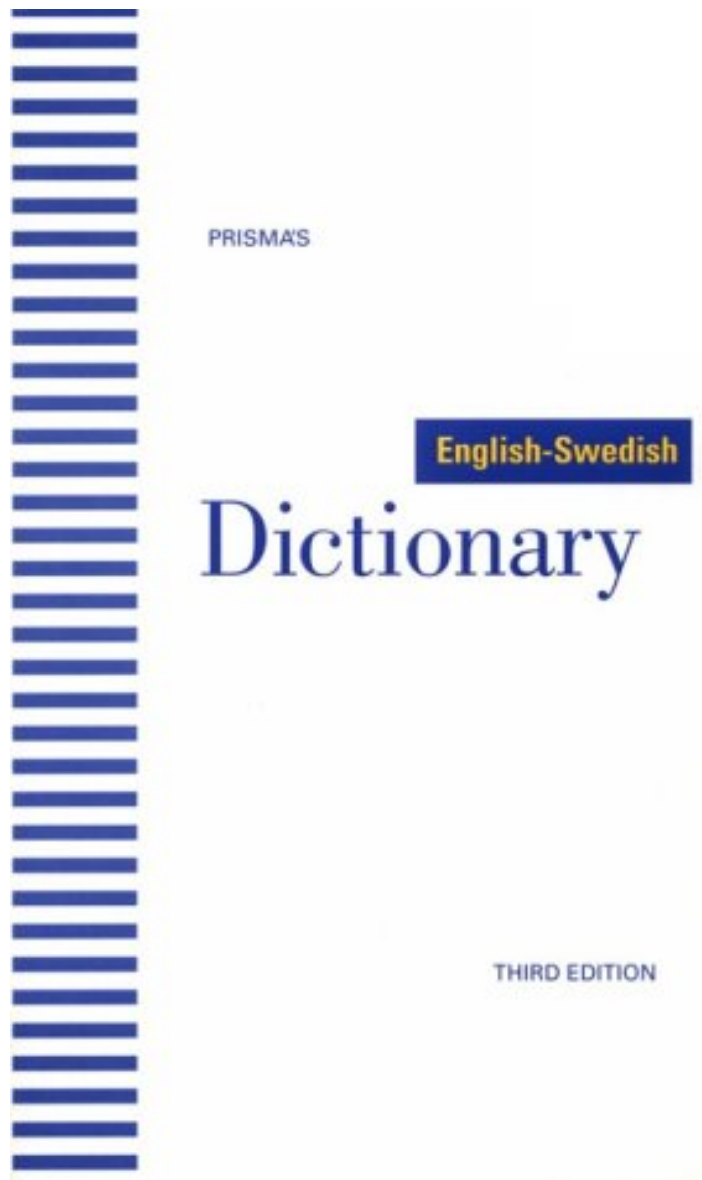

will see the exact same reviews despite there being different ISBN numbers. I hope figures this out and corrects it. That being said, I did get "fooled" into buying this because it is listed as "English and Swedish" version, which I assumed to mean that you could look up either language and get the translation. Nope. It's just a one way street. I have the Swedish-English version (yellow cover) and it is very thick with lots of words, but I just realized as I wanted to know a word... I couldn't even look it up because I don't know what it is! Basically you'll have to get both books (which will be pricy), but there don't seem to be a lot of options, either. Try holding out, maybe Langenschildt will release a new Swedish version of their dictionaries, which are awesome. Other than that it seems very comprehensive, the spine being over an inch thick. By Music Fan This dictionary (the Swedish-English version) is quite nice, but it is clearly intended for use by native Swedish speakers. There are no Swedish pronunciations given. And the front matter that describes the conventions of the dictionary and has (apparently) grammar notes, etc., is all in Swedish, so as an English speaker learning Swedish I can't make any sense of it. Furthermore, most of the grammar jargon words used in the front matter do not appear in the dictionary, so I couldn't even try to figure out what they were saying!
