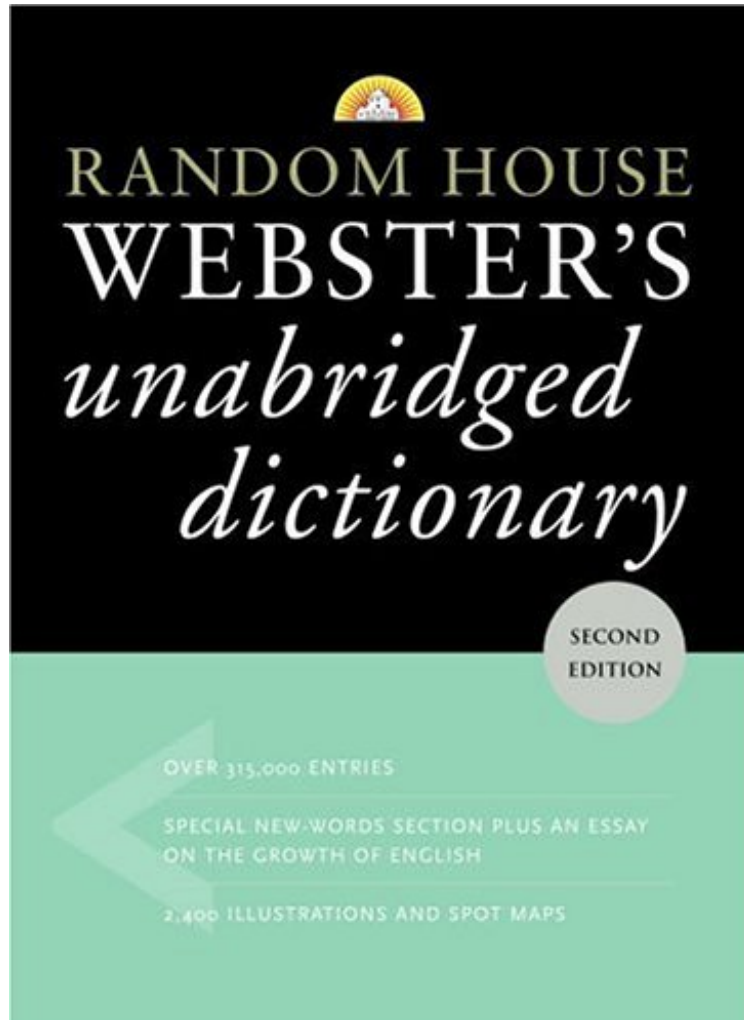

Of them all, the one I use is the Random House, I don't know what these guys are complaining about, it's not quite as comprehensive as the Third World, but I never use my Third World unless I'm trying to work out...it's just too big and heavy to be practical.My American Heritage a nice looking Dictionary with color pictures, but it's also too big and heavy...and not as comprehensive as the Random House. As I

said, the Random House is plenty comprehensive for me, it's relatively light weight (as compared with the Third World and the Amer Her), and the print is very easy to see (great contrast between black/bold and regular print. This one gets lots of use....and I haven't come across any words it does not have an entry for. Example X-Ref button, its displayed in the printed documentation, but no explanation of what it does. You cant find any reference to it at all by accessing help within the program. You can however find an explanation in the readme30 document on the cd-rom. The online help button in the program just links you to the Microsoft web site, WHY ? Second - poor integration into word. Even though there are explicit instructions I could not get it to integrate into Word 2000 under WindowsME. This new edition serves the same faithful, comprehensive reference function with even better, dated etymology. Physically the volume is very well made with fine paper and sturdy binding. It lacks, however, several appendices--- US Constitution, UN Charter, and especially concise foreign language translational dictionaries: Spanish, French, German, Italian---which I cut from the disintegrated old edition and save along with my separate thesaurus.
