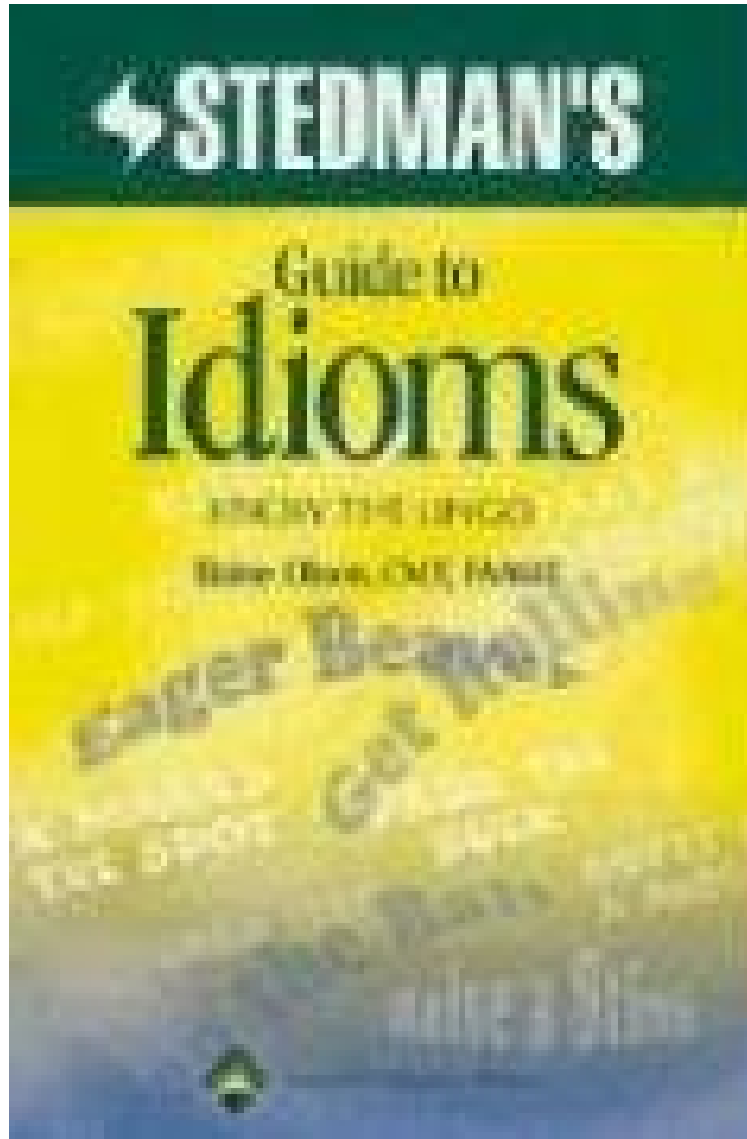

would even be used in medical transcription. When have you every heard a doctor dictate- "the resident fiddled while Rome burned"? This might be a useful book for those learning English as a second language, not for medical professionals. Poor job Stedman's. Not a useful reference at all.
