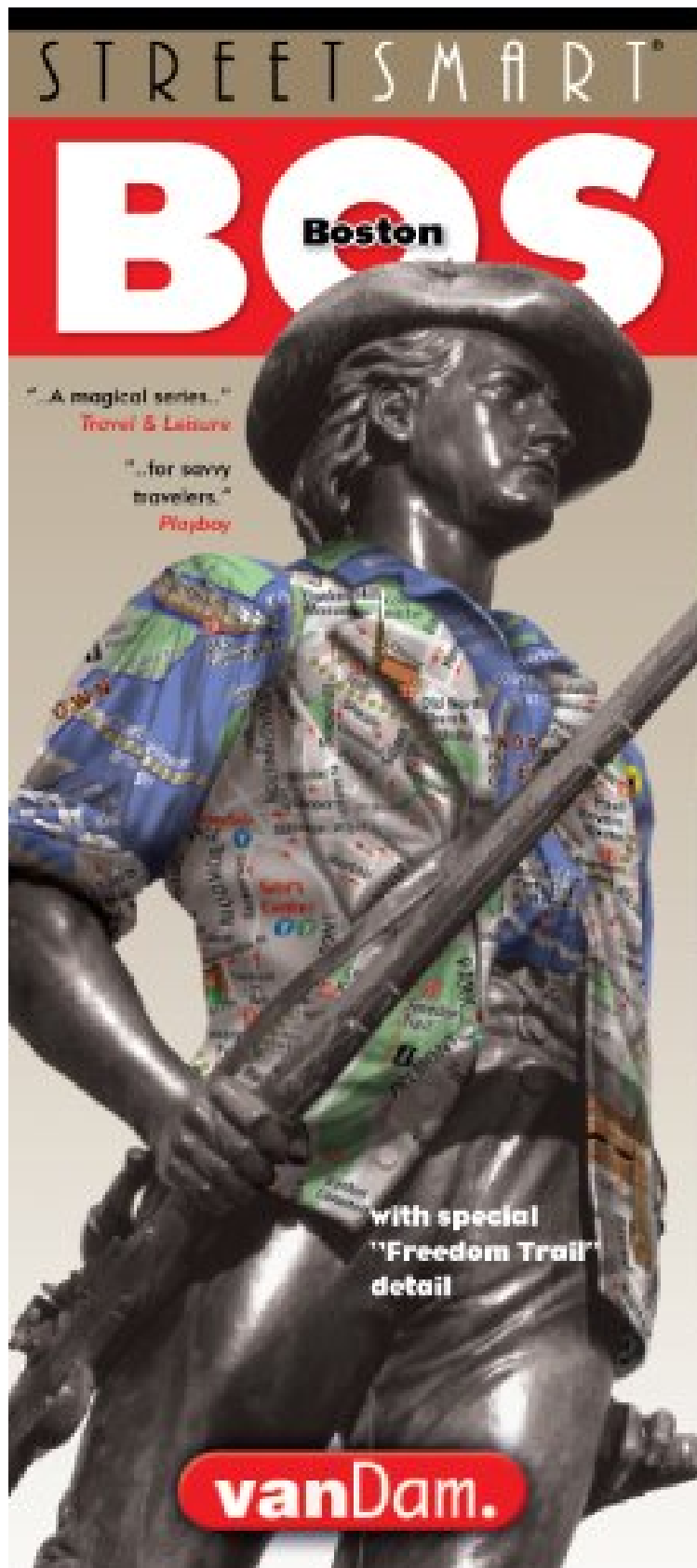

This is a map that tries -- but the fact that the map appears to continue but is actually dislocated represents one of the most inexplicable mistakes one could make in constructing a map. What do I mean? The main map folds out to six pagelets. Halfway across the six pages, every street is suddenly jerked north six inches. Just as one is getting a sense of a route or a neighborhood, it's not next to anything it's next to. Who makes a map that isn't continuous???Just an awful decision -- and frustrating and confounding enough that I really never use it. I was trying to de-confuse myself.....Having the Charles River and every street suddenly jump so that one needs to re-center oneself all over again just didn't help.
