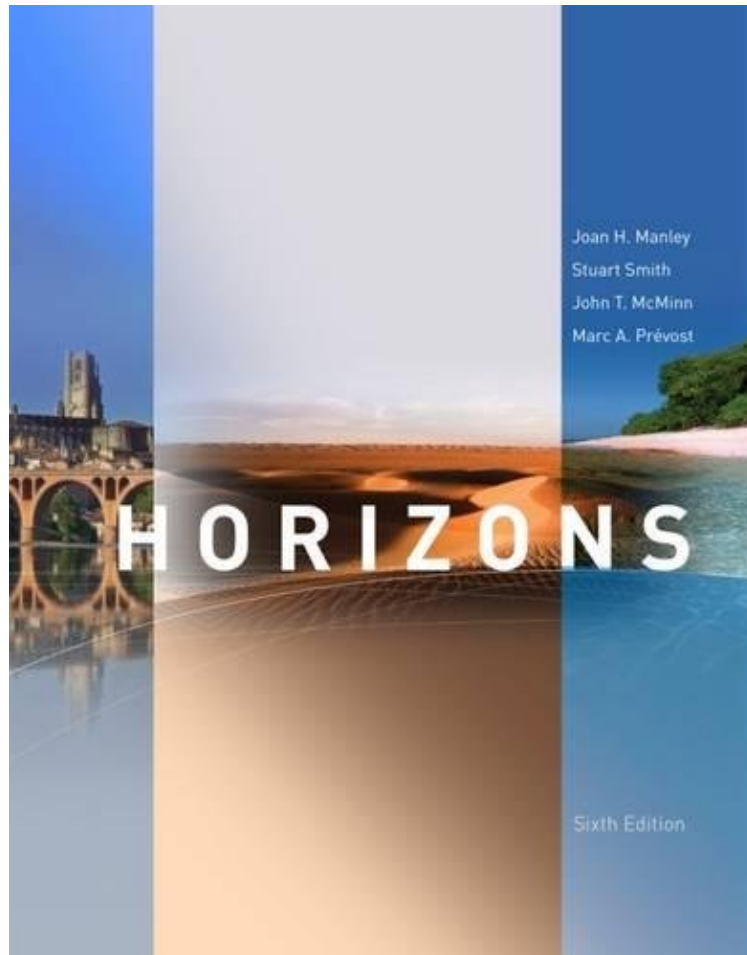

Since the book key and the materials it unlocks are part of the homework requirements for the class, it would have been good to have state that clearly in the ad for this book, so that students could make the choice with all information available. Alternatively, if a book key

could be provided (perhaps in collaboration with Quia Books) even if the price is higher, that would be an acceptable choice too. I would like to see do their due diligence for these.

The Student Activities Manual closely follows the organization of the main text to provide additional reading, writing, listening, and pronunciation practice outside of class.
