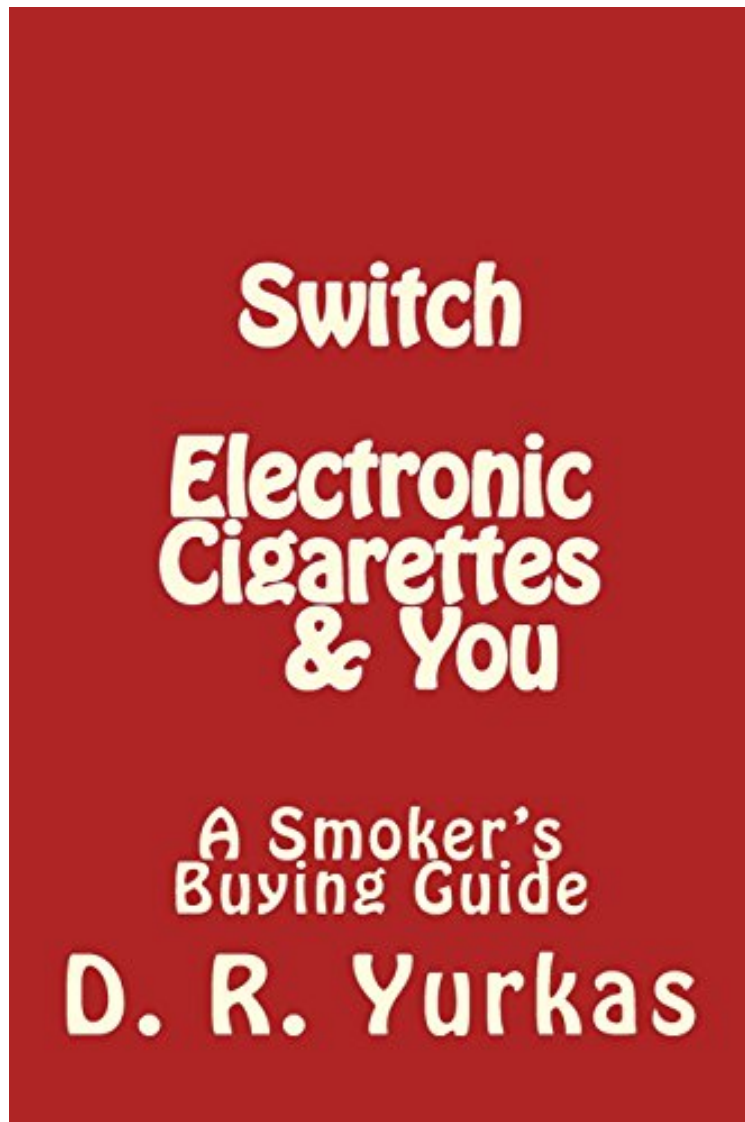

Good info - some errors By B Alexander In all, this is a good read for someone interested in electronic cigarettes or, as they are becoming known, personal vaporizers (PV). Although fraught with too many typos to mention (the editor should be ashamed), the basics are generally covered and, as an

introduction, it arms the reader with knowledge that will help them greatly on the path to selecting and using a PV and the associated devices. There are, however, a few factual errors that I would like to point out:- Some, but not all Variable Voltage PVs have removable batteries. The Joyetech eGo Twist and Vision Spinner, for instance, do not. Variable voltage PVs do not "...automatically adjust your voltage to the cartomizer or atomizer you put on the device...". This is what a Variable Wattage device like the Darwin and ZMax does. Variable Voltage PV's allow YOU to adjust the voltage to the varying resistance of your atomizing devices and to "dial in" your best vape for the atomizing device and e-liquid being used.- eGo cones are not drip shields as they are not sealed. These cones are for cosmetic purposes and to help guard against damage should you drop your eGo or leave it in your pocket and bend over (not suggested).- There are clearomizers that are small for use on mini class (analog sized) batteries. These are often called CE2's though that name may also be applied to other clearomizers.- The blu e-cigarette is not an 808 device; it is a 510 mini like the Joyetech 510 mini's. By the way, the reputable e-cigarette suppliers that use an 808 standard, like Smokeless Image and Bloog mentioned in the book, use the KR808-D1 standard connector threading. Those awful we-just-want-your-money scammer type companies use the much less standard KR808-D2 threading which is not compatible with the D1 standard. As the author says, stay away from these vendors (and there are many of them) and DO NOT sign up for any automatic shipment of supplies. I would also dissent from the author's opinion that Variable Voltage devices are not suggested for new vapers. I see her point that keeping it simple is important but a new vaper can very easily set their VV device to a standard 3.7 volts and leave it there until they have become acquainted enough with the equipment to properly deal with the added variable. As I stated earlier, the book is quite worthwhile and, especially at the price of the Kindle version, well worth reading as an introduction to electronic cigarettes and as a true help in not making many of the "newbie" mistakes. 5 of 5 people found the following review helpful.
