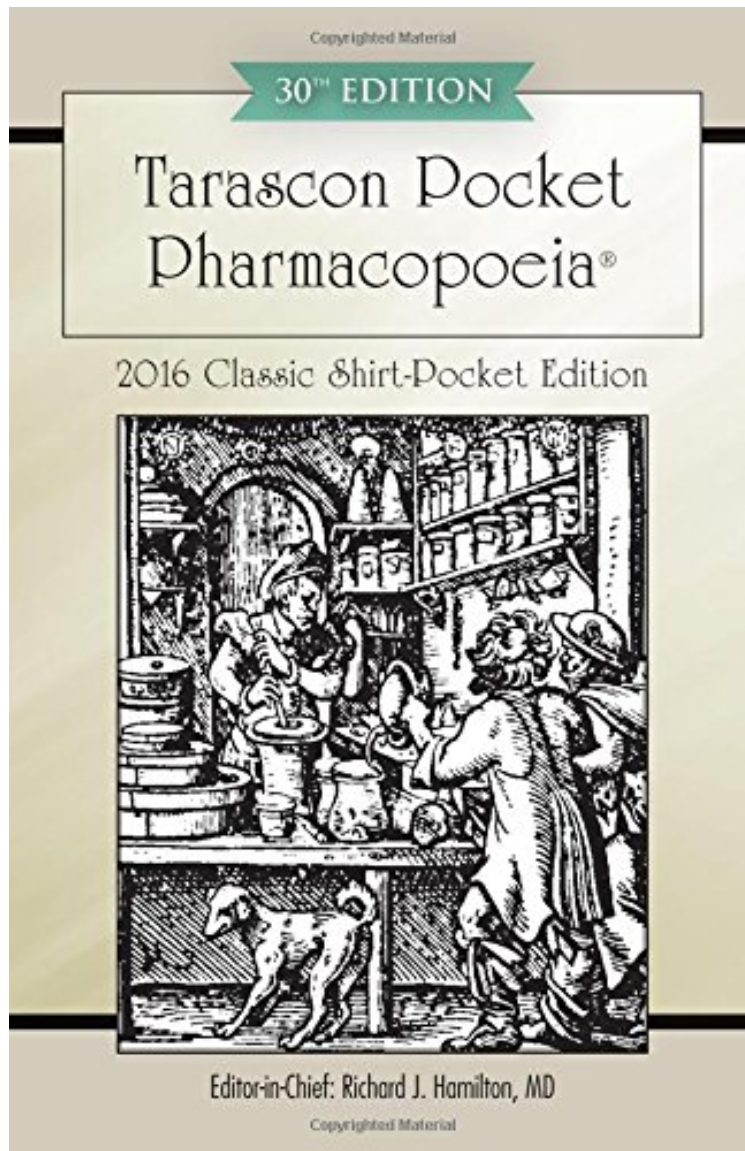

this new edition to replace my older labcoat 2013 edition. The lab coat edition with 500s pages it feels heavy when I put it in the lab coat pocket, so I wanted to try this smaller version this time. Now I have been using this for couple weeks, and I miss the lab coat edition since it brings much more detailed dosage information for each medications such as dosages for unlabeled use. The lab coat edition also provides brief information for each category of medications such as contraindications and major interactions. If you have been practicing long enough that you are familiar with all medications that you usually Rx then get this one, but I strongly recommend to get lab coat edition if you are still new to the field.*****Updated 09/30/2016: Been using this manual for months now, I am downgrading this product to 1 star since I have been frustrated because of 2 drawbacks. First, multiple page numbers for some commonly prescribed drugs on index section. There is no way to find out which page number is for actual dosage information. Many drugs have 5-6 different page numbers listed so I have to go back and forth to index page until I find actual dosage information. It could have been solved easily if the editor marked the page number which contains actual dosage info with bold font. Secondly, the page numbers of certain drugs on index page are plainly wrong. Many times when I try to find certain drug on the page as indicated on index section, I can't. Then, I finally find it on the previous or next page. But that's after I spend 10s of seconds to find on the page as indicated on index section. The index of the older editions of this manual used to indicate the page numbers and even what part of the page (top, bottom) could the drug be found.. Why did I purchase this product when I can use cellphone app for free? Because it should be much quicker to look up on pocket manual than punching in the drug name on cellphone app.4 of 4 people found the following review helpful.
