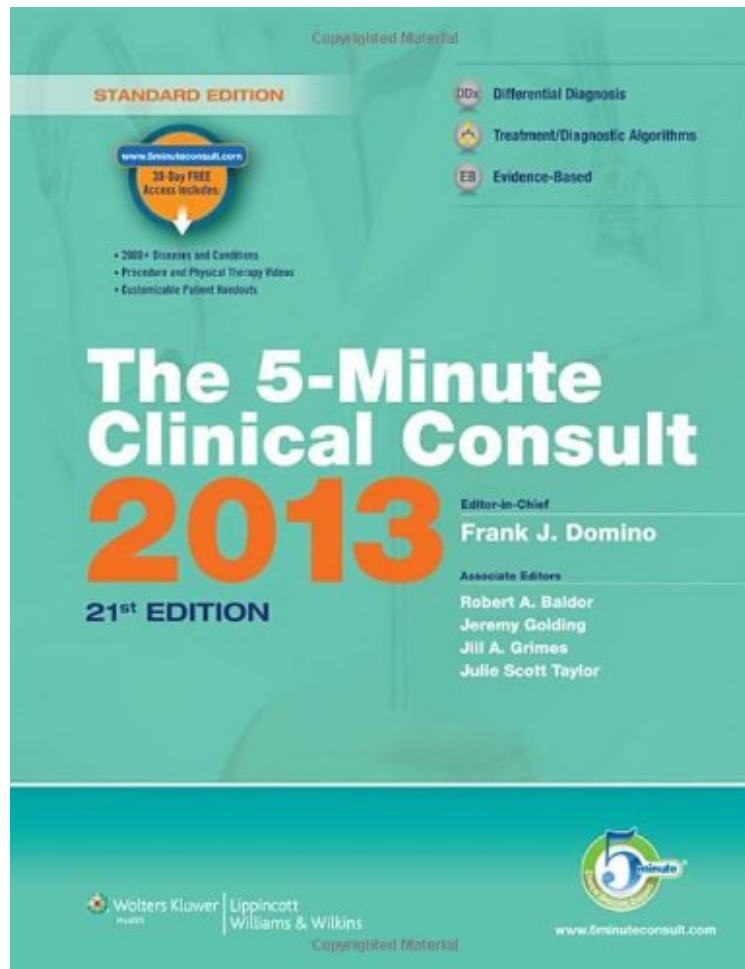

I used it through NP school as an adjunct to my course materials to study for tests. Now that I am practicing as a family nurse practitioner for almost a year, I still am finding it useful. It is an affordable and easy to use resource if you are unable to subscribe to more expensive resources like UpToDate. The book is formatted in alphabetical order, so you look up your condition i.e. UTI and use it like a dictionary, flipping to the U's. It then has a 2 page layout on s/sx, physical exam, patho, epidemiology, diagnostics, labs, f/u, prevention, complications, and clinical pearls. I have used it mostly to familiarize myself with EBP first and second line tx. Even when I have students shadowing me they like the format and content of the book and read it on and off throughout the day. The online 5 minute consult website is comparable to UTD and is about half the price to subscribe to. I recommend getting the book and it comes with a 30 day free trial to the online resource which has adults and an optional (add'l price) pediatric resource.
