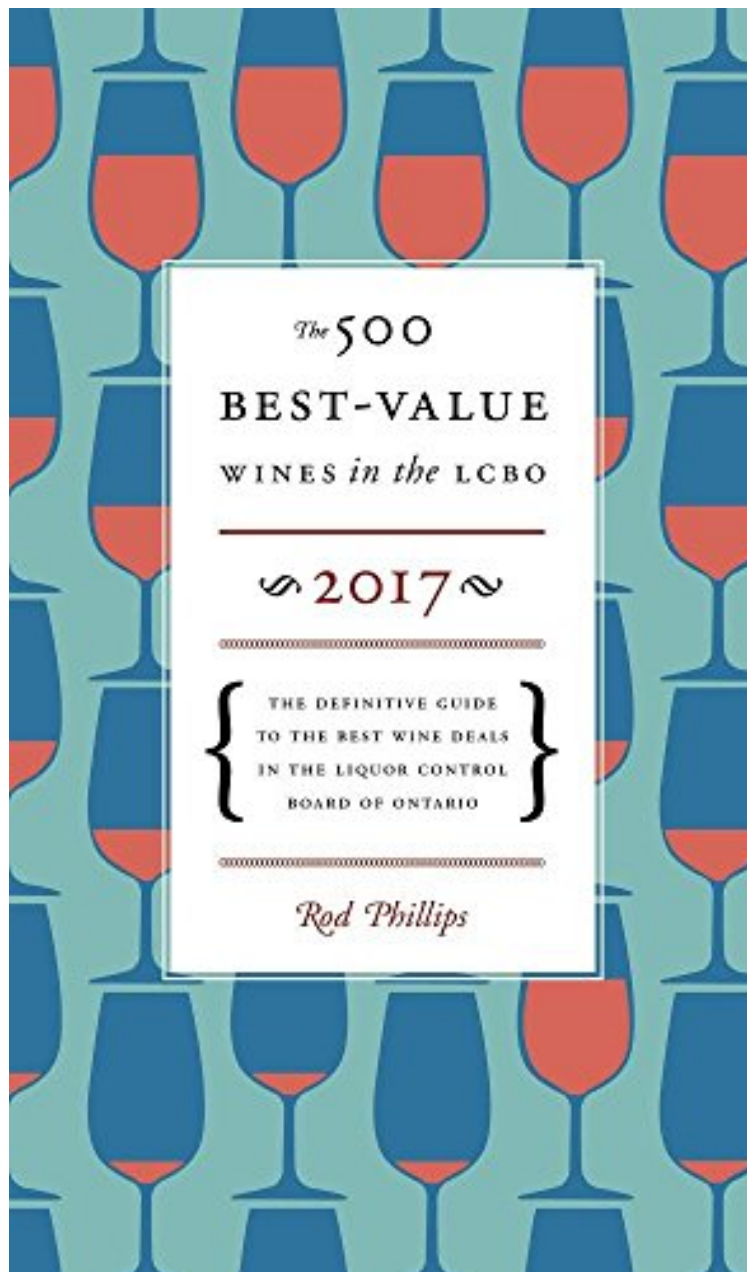


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The 500 Best-Value Wines in the LCBO 2017: The Definitive Guide to the Best Wine Deals in the Liquor Control Board of Ontario
