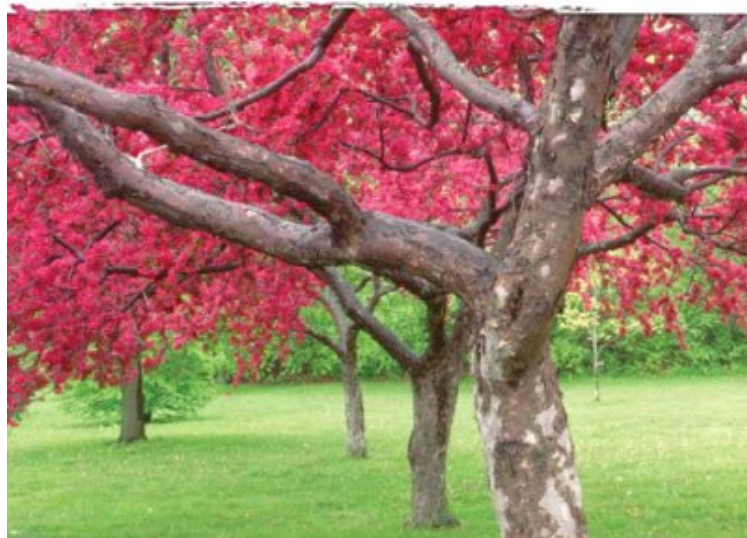
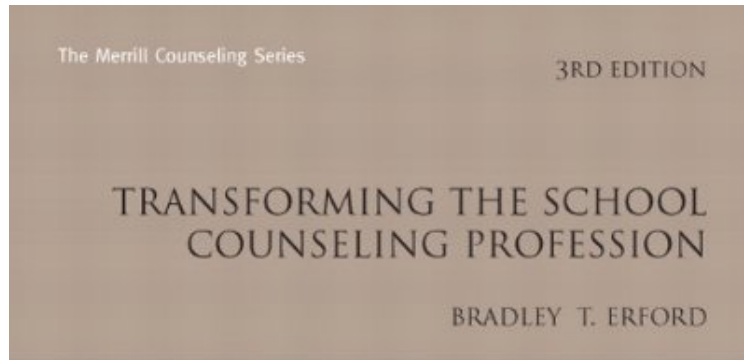

Besides not having any illustrations, the spelling is awful! So awful that I had to reread the sentence/paragraph again because of how frustrated I was! What 3rd edition Master level textbook has so many mistakes! Chapter 1 had so many mistakes that I stopped counting.
