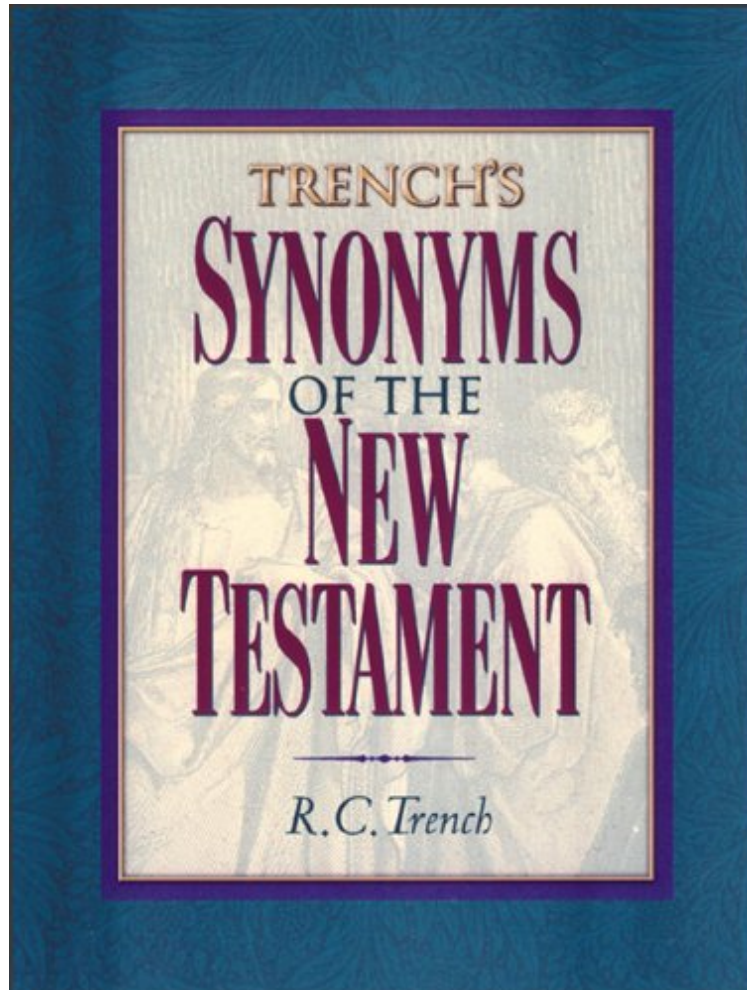

I would have given it 5 stars, except that I am too often disappointed to find that the synonyms that I want to look at were not chosen by Trench. However, the ones he has chosen are compared in great detail and help illuminate the New Testament koine Greek text. I also like the fact that one of my favorite Greek lexicons, Thayer's Greek-English Lexicon of the New Testament, refers to Trench in entries that are included in this fine text. I'm not sure if it is true that this resource would be helpful for anyone with no knowledge of New Testament Greek. So I would caution against it. Regarding the Kindle edition, I noticed that the sample given here on line is also sideways. Caveat emptor. Lastly it is interesting to see some of Trench's other accomplishments. As were so many scholars of his time he was multifaceted. A remarkable man. He loved words and as such was a member of London's
