I got this for a friend who's learning English, who was skeptical that an older version would be better than this newer one. I was mildly curious myself and decided to get both versions just to be sure. As it turns out, the newer version is indeed bigger and has a larger printing font, but contains a far less number of definitions. Well,what can you do? You can get the older and way cheaper version is what you can do. As a fluent speaker of both English and Spanish I was actually a bit surprised to find some words I don't use very often, and others I have never even heard of. The 1984 edition is not by any means inferior, it is in fact the recommended choice. A dictionary is not like a health, fashion or medical book whose contents become less relevant with age. It is a book that preserves our language and remains useful decades after its printing. In this case it turns out to be superior to newer versions.
