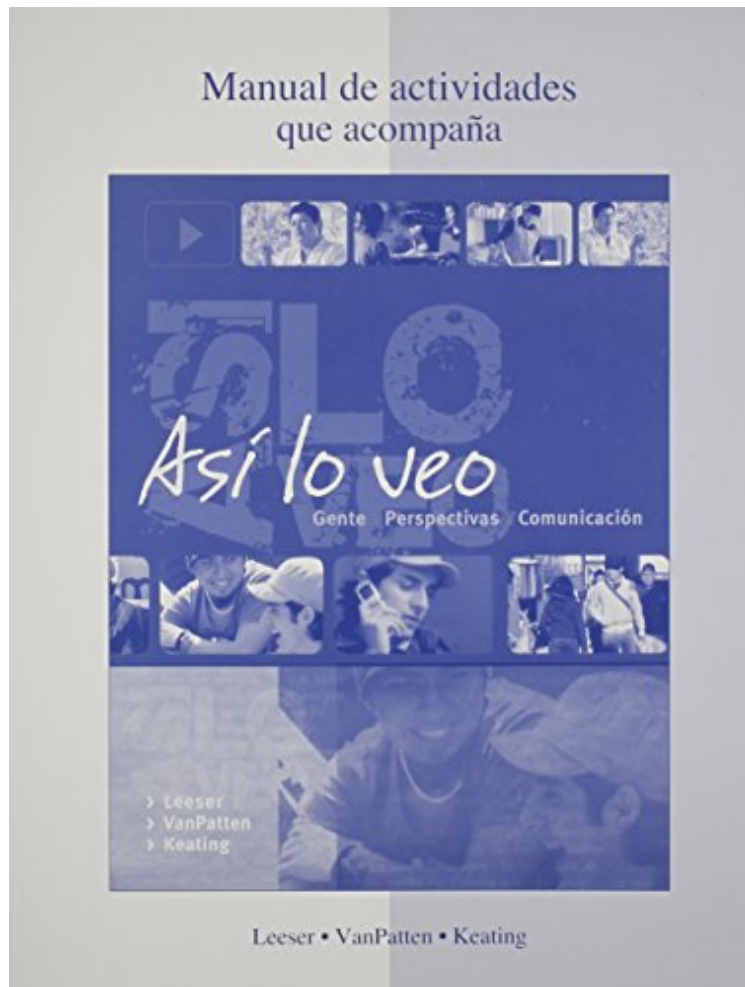

His research interests include input processing during second language reading as well as second language classroom interaction. His research has appeared in journals such as *Studies in Second Language Acquisition* and *Language Teaching Research*. He also co-authored *Sol y viento* and *Sol y viento: En breve* (2008, McGraw-Hill).
