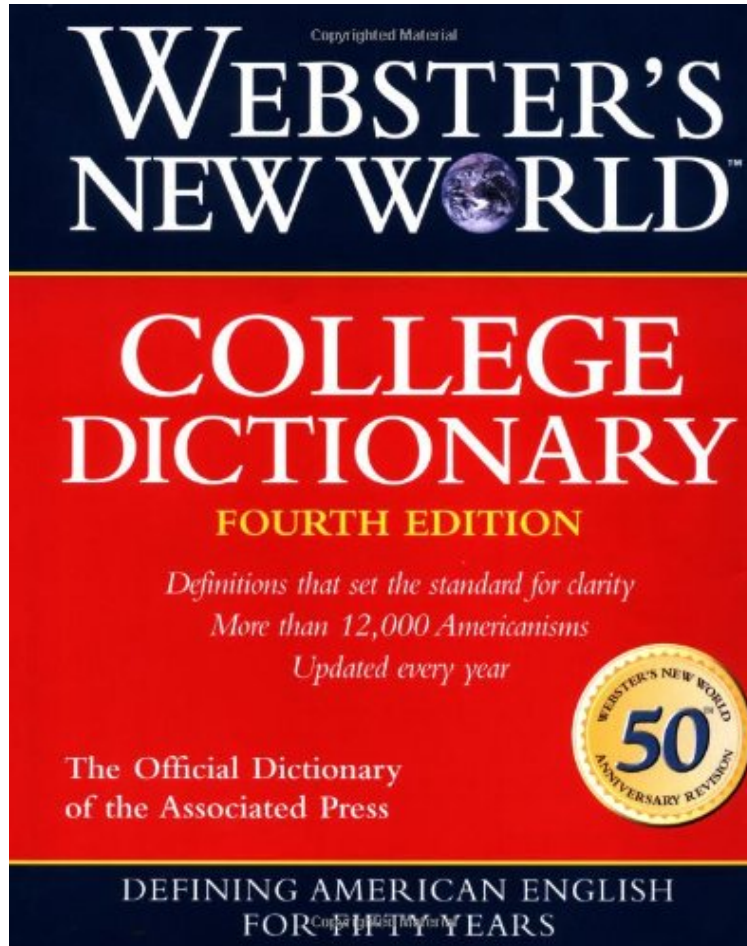

It looks like new, but a few (very few) pages have wrinkles that look like they happened when it was published. Also, the copy I got has a thumb index, which was a nice surprise. It was exactly what I wanted. There are pictures, tables, and a lot more. The print is a little small, and the dictionary is little thick. Over 1700 pages. The disk loads in a matter of minutes, and offers a linked thesaurus with the dictionary--you can choose one or both reference tools, and you can customize both with your particular notes. Kids who are told to "look it up" when they ask mom how to spell a word will love the Misspeller's Dictionary included on the disk, which can easily translate spellings like "wierd" and "anoy".
