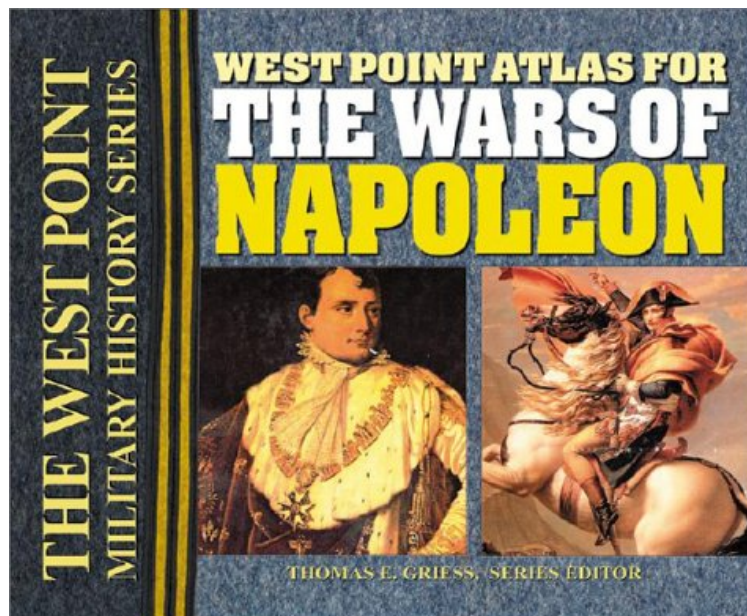

The color registration is off slightly on some maps (the overprinting is a little visible). As other reviewers have noted, a history/description is needed in order to understand the maps and why the various arrows went where they did.
